



# Sexting Citations: What Happens Next

- **First time offenders\* will be issued a citation and receive a court date**
- **Youth may complete one of the following sanctions:**
  1. **(8) community service hours**

- **Upon submitting proof of completion of one of the above, the Judge may choose to cancel the hearing and close the case**
  - **Youth will be contacted by Court Case Manager to notify them of cancellation**
- **If the youth does not complete one of requirements and/or at the Court's discretion, the youth is required to be present in Court on the date and time previously provided**

*\*A second sexting violation results in first-degree misdemeanor charges, while any further violations are punishable as a third-degree felony*
